EMPOWERING PEOPLE FOR 39 YEARS ANNUAL REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005-06

Home of Guiding Hands (HGH) is achieving its mission tenet of empowering people with developmental disabilities toward self-dependence one person at a time. During the 2005-2006 fiscal year, participation in HGH's programs and

services increased by 31 percent over the previous fiscal year, with a total of 382 San Diego County residents and their families receiving valuable training, residential and support services from HGH.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Family and Friends:

What an exciting year 2005-06 was for HGH. As new outreach initiatives took effect (including the creation of a Community Relations Committee), participation in HGH's programs and public awareness increased, and several new board members joined our forces.

One of the most innovative highlights for HGH this year was the debut of the Life Planning program, which received start-up grant funding from the California State Council on Developmental Disabilities. This unique new program guided 77 full-time family caregivers in the development of a life plan that provides for their disabled family member and their entire family. In 2006-07, we will expand the program to benefit not only the family caregivers of people with developmental disabilities, but also those who have children with mental illness.

In all, HGH assisted 382 individuals with developmental disabilities and their families during fiscal year 2005-06 through its comprehensive residential, training and support services. HGH's services are individualized and vary according to need. However, each and every service aims to encourage maximum choice, personal growth and self-dependence. From fulfilling the dreams of three very disabled residents who wished to go on a cruise, and encouraging another resident who is blind to participate in Special Olympics Bowling, to supporting an individual to communicate using sign language, assisting a person living independently to balance their checkbook, and teaching a child with autism to read, HGH's support achievements were many and varied this year.

In addition to the life enhancements HGH facilitated for its program participants, several organizational goals were also accomplished. These included the completion of a five-year strategic plan that moved HGH residents and operations to the community (finalized with the move of administrative offices to leased office space in El Cajon, in August 2005). As a direct result of this plan, the organization experienced an unprecedented financial achievement; HGH completed the 2005-06 fiscal year with a \$380,000 surplus over expense. These funds are being held in our investment reserve to secure the future of existing programs and potential future expansion.

Other 2005-06 highlights included:

- A record-breaking net profit was raised at the 32nd Annual Heart & Hand Ball (\$104,000)
- The 1st Annual Tea Event was hosted
- Plans were finalized for HGH Partners for Today and Tomorrow, a mission-centered capacity building program that will be initiated in 2006-07.

At HGH, we strive to continually improve our services to meet the needs of the people we serve, their families and our community. Support at the local level is crucial to these improvement efforts, especially in terms of money and volunteer commitment. A list of our generous supporters is included in this report, but there are also countless contributions of time and energy from nearly 300 active volunteers that you will not find on our balance sheet. We are grateful to all of our contributors. Your generosity makes a difference in the lives of those we assist each and every day.

Please accept my sincere thanks for your continuing interest and dedication.

recertification classes, as well as scholarship opportunities for higher education at an accredited college or university.

HGH is growing and flexing its services to meet the ever-changing needs of the San Diego community. This past fiscal year demonstrates our ability to progressively respond to these needs. In response to the community's need for life planning assistance, HGH created in 2005-06 the Life Planning program, which provides a series of workshops for the full-time caregivers of family members with disabilities and other special needs. The In-Home Respite program was also expanded to serve more pre-school and school-age children. In 2005-06, participation in the In-Home Respite program grew 32 percent over the previous year.

HGH's services now include:

- Residential – Offers affordable housing through 28 homes (27 homes as of July 2006), round-the-clock training and support for very-low income individuals (age 17 and older) with mental retardation, autism, cerebral palsy and epilepsy. The majority is also non-verbal; some are blind or deaf; and others are unable to walk without the assistance of a wheelchair or walker. HGH staff also coordinates recreation and leisure activities and ensures that each resident's healthcare needs are met. This program served 176 individuals during 2005-06.

- In-Home Respite – Provides a much-needed break for families caring for children and/or relatives (age 3 and older) with developmental disabilities, as well as one-to-one training, tutoring and companionship for their child/relative. This program assisted 112 individuals and their families during 2005-06.

- Community Living – Offers support with budgeting, banking, shopping, nutrition, cooking and meal preparation, relationship and employment issues, and much more for individuals who reside independently in an apartment or home of their own. This service supported 17 individuals during 2005-06.

- Health Services Center – Provides a central location for community physicians, dentists and other health-care professionals to provide preventative and routine care. The center provided care for the 176 individuals receiving HGH's Residential Services in 2005-06.

- Life Planning Project – A six-session workshop series designed to assist families supporting and caring for children and/or relatives with developmental disabilities and other special needs to develop a life plan that incorporates the future needs and desires of the entire family. The program debuted in 2005-06 with start-up grant funds from the California State Council on Developmental Disabilities. HGH will expand the program to neighboring counties on a fee for service basis in the coming years. The program provided life planning assistance for 77 individuals and their families during 2005-06.

FINANCIALS

Fiscal Year End June 30, 2006

For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, Home of Guiding Hands and Affiliates received more than \$11.4 million in support and revenue for its programs and services for people with developmental disabilities. There was an increase of almost 7 percent in the program reimbursement from the State effective August 2005, for the majority of the residential homes; while the signature event, the Heart and Hand Ball, netted a record-breaking \$104,000. HGH ended the fiscal year with a \$379,544 net income over expense and is proud to report that 84 cents of every dollar raised directly supports its programs.

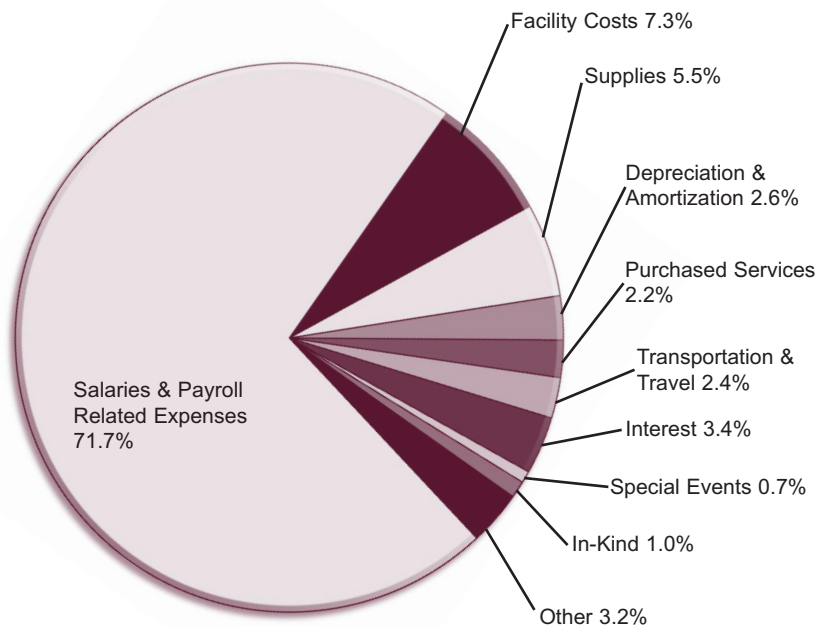
