Annual Report for Fiscal Year 2007-08

Dear Family and Friends:

Challenge and confidence: these are the watchwords of 2009.

The budget stalemate in Sacramento is finally over, but its impact will be deep and far-reaching. Cuts in funding and support for California's neediest citizens have already begun and are expected to continue for several years to come. There is no doubt that those cuts will impact HGH. But we have faced challenges before and we are confident that we will survive these reductions as well. Regional Center and providers like HGH will receive a 3% reduction in reimbursements, which is effective immediately and will continue through June 30, 2010. But there is more. The Department of Developmental Services must reduce its expenses by \$100 million dollars, which will translate to a 7.1% reduction to Regional Centers and providers of service. In all, HGH is facing a combined 10.1 percent reduction in funds from the regional center.

However, we are in a better position than most organizations to withstand this potential crisis because the board has been working over the past three years to build reserves and protect our assets. A reasonable, sustaining strategy is being put into place that will protect the lives of those we support; our consumers, families, and staff.

We have not let financial issues distract us from our most important work, and have set goals that focus on our core mission to provide quality support services, training, and advocacy for people with developmental disabilities, their families and others who will benefit. Those goals for 2009 include: strengthening stable staffing levels in homes to enhance consistency and service to residents; encouraging new partnerships and supporters of HGH; and evaluating the creation of potential services where unmet needs exist. This year, we began offering respite services for caregivers of seniors who are not developmentally disabled, but who benefit from the personal and household services we can provide because the seniors are too frail to be left without supervision.

This has also been a year of positive growth for the residents in our 28 homes:

Thanks to a generous grant from the Citigroup Foundation, many residents improved their communication skills with the help of assistive technology. A touch screen computer gave residents a new way to interact with each other and staff at LRW, and educational software games opened up new worlds at LRW, Aquilla, Castillo Verde, Ventana, and GHC homes. Games, puzzles, and sensory items made learning fun at 18 homes

The HGH board continues to attract individuals who bring new ideas and expertise to the work. This year, we welcomed Jim O'Grady, Randy Rundle, Joan Stein, and Dave Catalino. And on a sad note, we mourned the loss of long-time board member and one of HGH's biggest champions, Bob Sennett.

Yes, there have been many challenges in 2008 and there will be many more in the months to come. But we face them with the confidence of 40 years of experience, knowing that the HGH organization will always be there to serve and support those who depend on us. We begin the New Year with optimism, and, as always, with heartfelt gratitude for your continuing support.

Fiscal Year End June 30, 2008

For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, Home of Guiding Hands Corporation and Affiliates received more than \$11 million in support and revenue for its programs and services. Long-term investments experienced a market loss for the year, in spite of the addition of \$325,000 to the Board Designated Endowment Fund. **We are proud to report that 87 cents of every dollar generated this year directly supported HGH's programs and services.**
